Where are we now (I)?

- Contract signed with BT on 21st March, achieved target at lowest cost nationally
- 90% of all premises will have access to lines capable of superfast broadband by 2015
- 57,000 extra premises with superfast broadband, with 40,000 getting between 50-80Mbps
- All premises will have access to a minimum 2Mbps by 2015
- Around 3,500 premises will require uplift above 2Mbps (>1%)
- Around 58,000 premises left between 2 - 24Mbps



Where are we now (2)?

- Phase 1 and first cabinet to go live January 14 (Oakley)
- 8 Phases in total completed by December 2015
- 7 Phases delivering superfast broadband, Phase 8 providing 'in-fill'
- Phases are modeled to achieved best value – progressively more challenging
- Current data on intervention is at sector level SO23 8 rather than SO23 8UJ)
- Post Code level will be available 3 months ahead of each phase
