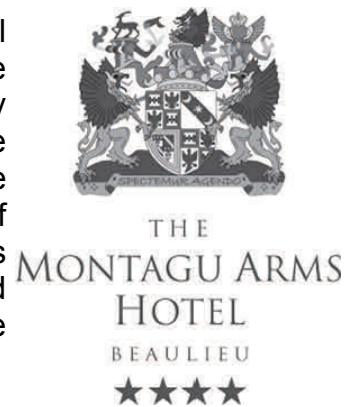

Situated in the centre of Beaulieu, The Montagu Arms Hotel has carried out extensive work externally to improve the energy efficiency of windows and doors within a historically listed building without affecting the overall look of the building. Internally, thicker loft insulation, the widespread use of energy saving light bulbs and a much greater staff awareness for the need to turn off computers, printers, lights and other electrical appliances when not in use has resulted in a significant drop in the level of utilities consumed at the site.



A fully functional local sourcing policy ensures, where possible, food used in the two restaurants at the hotel is purchased from local suppliers or grown and picked in the hotel's very own kitchen garden.



The kitchen garden (also an educational resource) has been developed to produce food for use in the hotel restaurant, complete with free-range chickens to provide eggs for breakfast. The team have also installed a rocket composter, an in-vessel system that efficiently composts food waste. Food waste is a significant part of the hotel's waste and it is anticipated that the rocket composter will reduce the amount of waste generated by almost half and hotel staff are monitoring the effectiveness of the project.

Customers are offered a 10% reduction in room rates on production of a valid ticket for travel to the New Forest via public transport. Once here, the hotel recommends guests further utilise the extensive public transport links, or alternatively use one of the New Forest electric Twizys to travel around the local area.
