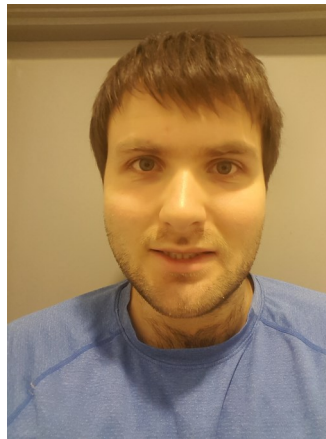


The Eric Robinson Award for Young Person in Business
