Students and staff at Brockenhurst College participate regularly in a variety of social action activities designed to benefit the local community. For example, Art & Design and Graphics students recently worked on a project called Heads UP for mental health charity Solent Mind. This initiative aims to help local school children learn to manage their mental health and wellbeing through interactive workshops.

Art & Design students created animations to be shown during the school sessions, while Graphics students designed illustrations for a story called 'Relax like a cat', which is now told during interactive sessions with Year R and Year 1 pupils.

Meanwhile, Foundation Studies students participated in this year's New Forest National Park Authority's 'National Spring Clean' campaign, which runs in March and April.

The College also runs its annual All-Ways Safe & Drive Safe campaign, which is spearheaded by a multi-agency information event held on campus. The event features exhibits, demonstrations, talks and activities designed to help young people identify and avoid dangerous situations

The College encourages students and staff to undertake fundraising activities for national, regional and local charities. Many successful initiatives take place each year, highlighting the overarching community-orientated spirit at the college. Annual projects include hosting Oakhaven Hospice's Colour Run, plus raising money for Children in Need, the Poppy Appeal, Macmillan Cancer Trust and the Honey Pot Christmas Shoebox Appeal.
